Suicide is a complex, multidimensional event warranting comprehensive, integrative, multidiscipline prevention and intervention efforts. Suicidal emergencies have commonalities, as well as distinctions as they affect various populations. Specifically, Veterans and members of the US military. In this workshop, attendees will learn the most recent data concerning suicide; critical assessment parameters of the recognition of at-risk individuals; and dialogue on how to identify and refer at-risk individuals.
